

## **BUK Shines At WAUG, Gets 8 Medals**

The Bayero University contingent at the just concluded West African Universities Games (WAUG) held at the University of Ilorin demonstrated exuberance, commitment and exemplified a high sense of sportsmanship to emerge 15<sup>th</sup> out of 53 West African Universities with 8 medals.

The camp of Bayero University was in high spirits with the presence of the Deputy Vice Chancellor, (Administration), Professor Abdurashid Garba, who represented the Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Rasheed. The athletes were overwhelmed with his eloquence and outstanding motivational techniques to be good ambassadors of the University and use the avenue to strengthen mutual friendship with athletes from other African and Nigerian Universities.

Speaking, the Director of Sports, Dr. Musa Garba Yakasai, said the University athletes made an outstanding performance having

emerged 15<sup>th</sup> out of 53 Nigerian and African Universities with 1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze medals in Judo, 1 silver in Badminton (single), 1 bronze in Badminton (female double) and 1 silver in 400 meters.

The Sports Director added that the University athletes in Basketball, Football, and Table Tennis put the University's name on the front burner, as the athletes had initially promised the Vice Chancellor that they would return to Kano with silverware.

At the end of the exercise, BUK's Chairman of Sports Consultative Committee, Dr. Balarabe A. Haruna, was elected as the North-Zonal Coordinator of the West African Universities Games after the Director of Sports, Dr. Musa Garba Yakasai, made an excellent campaign among the Sports Directors of the Northern Universities.

## **WAUG Commends BUK For Non-Mercenary Athletes**

For the first time in the history of Sports participation, Bayero University paraded 100% bona fide

athletes, who represented it at the just concluded West African Universities Games (WAUG) held at the University of Ilorin, Kwara State from 27<sup>th</sup> March to 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2012.

The WAUG officials were highly elated after screening the athletes through their online registration data and other necessary documents and found that no single mercenary was used by Bayero University.

Even the Minister of Education, Professor Ruqayyatu Ahmed Rufa'i, gave BUK athletes a standing ovation during the opening ceremony, when she saw them dressed in colorful shadda attire.

The Sports Director, Dr. Musa Garba Yakasai, said the University achieved this feat through the commitment and contribution of the sports loving Vice Chancellor, who motivated the athletes and promised cash rewards for any medal.

## Medical Radiography Gets Accreditation Pass Mark

The Medical Radiography programme in Bayero University has received a boost from the Radiographers Registration Board of Nigeria (RRBN) after it conducted a pre-professional accreditation exercise with an excellent pass mark recently.

The Board, which sent a two-man team comprising the Registrar of the Board, Mr. Reuben Babatunde, and the Director of the Institute of Radiography, Mr. Michael S. Okpaleke, conducted a two-day verification exercise on the equipment, physical infrastructure and staffing.

Speaking shortly after the exercise, the Registrar, Mr. Babatunde, expressed the Board's appreciation over the installation of modern equipment at the Aminu Kano Teaching Hospital and School of Physiotherapy, Dala and commended the University for laying a solid physical infrastructure that would facilitate the smooth running of the Radiography programme.

The Registrar observed that there was the need for the University to employ more capable academic and administrative personnel, as well as equip the library with contemporary

Radiography -related resources before the next accreditation exercise.

The team further verified the curriculum, past question papers, marking scheme, lecture notes and advised appropriately.

In an interview, the Head of Radiography Department, Dr. Abdulkadir Musa Tabari, said even though the programme was only in its third year, it received high commendation from the Board and expressed optimism that effort would be mounted to ensure that the programme got full accreditation.

After the verification exercise the team paid a courtesy call on the Vice Chancellor.
