## BUK Mourns!

The Council, Management, Staff and Students of Bayero University, Kano, are shocked by the unprovoked and senseless attack on Christian worshippers on the Old Campus of the University on Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2012. The attack resulted in the death of a number of innocent people. Three of these are confirmed to be University staff members. They are: Prof. J.T. Ayodele of Chemistry Department, Prof. Andrew Leo of Library Science Department, and Mr. Sylvester Adah of Bursary Department. A number of other people sustained injuries.

The Management of the University, on behalf of the Council, staff and students, condoles with the families of all the deceased. May their souls rest in perfect peace, amen. It also prays for the quick recovery of all those injured.

Meanwhile, the Vice Chancellor has cut short his official visit to Malaysia due to what happened in the University. He starts the journey back home today, and is expected to arrive Kano tomorrow.

Due to the declaration of Tuesday, 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2012 as a public holiday by the Federal Government, work resumes in the University on Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> may, 2012. As usual essential services are not affected by the two work-free days.
