BUK Denies Affiliation with City College of Education, Mararaba Gurku, Nasarawa State

The Management of Bayero University, Kano has denied a purported affiliation with the City College of Education, Gurku, Nassarawa State.

The College, which is located at the Sani Abacha Road, Mararaba Nasarawa State claims to have fully affiliated with Bayero University and admits students in the name of the said affiliation.

A statement signed by the Registrar, Sani Ibrahim Amin, MNIM, said: "The facts of the matter are as follows: City College of Education applied to the University for affiliation in September, 2011. A Senate Committee visited the College

and assessed its human and material resources and reported back to Senate. After considering the report, the Senate declined to approve the application for affiliation. The College officials have been duly informed about the status of their application for affiliation.

We therefore wish to inform the general public that Bayero University does not have, and never had, any affiliation arrangement with the City College of Education for the purpose of running degree or any other programme. Anyone who deals with the College on the assumption of affiliation with Bayero University does so at his/her own risk.

Anyone found to be parading any document bearing the name or logo of Bayero University purportedly issued to him by the College will be arrested and appropriately prosecuted."
