Welcoming the graduands to the profession, the Chairman of the Association Nigerian Medical (NMA), Kano State Chapter, Dr. D. A. Ibrahim, admonished them to adhere ethical strictly to the guidelines, saying, "you should not allow yourselves to be found culpable for breaching the ethical codes".

Earlier in his welcome remarks, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar



Adamu Rasheed, mni, said it was a great day in the history of Bayero University, as the Faculty of Medicine recorded another milestone by graduating 40 young men and women in medical education.
