BUK Conducts Orientation for New Academic Staff

he Centre for Continuing Education and Professional Development (CCEPD) on Wednesday organized a one-day orientation programme for newly recruited academic staff at the Aminu Kano Centre for Democratic Research and Training (AKCDRT).

Delivering a keynote address, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed welcomed the new academic staff and congratulated them for joining the services of one of the top excellent Universities in Nigeria.

Bayero University Matriculates 5667 Students

total number of 5667 students **L**were admitted into Bayero University Kano the current at 2011/2012 academic session and were matriculated on Thursday 12th July, 2012 the Musa Abdullahi at Auditorium.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, mni, said 26,851 candidates qualified for admission, but 5667 were admitted based on merit.

Prof. Rasheed emphasized that the University has continued to be rated very highly in Nigeria, owing to its liberal tendencies for admission, where every state in Nigeria, including Abuja, was represented.

The Vice Chancellor told the fresh students that they should work assiduously to complement the efforts of the University for maintaining and sustaining its quest for excellence in all the ramifications of academic activities. He stressed that Bayero University was recently scored among



the 8 "A" Rated Universities in Nigeria by the National Universities Commission (NUC).

Professor Rasheed charged the new undergraduate students to be committed to their study and shun all forms of examination malpractice, stressing that BUK would not condone any act of cheating and malpractice, as it only graduated students who are found worthy of character and learning.

The Vice Chancellor said the University was going through a series of transformations in both physical and academic programmes with many programmes to be started in the new academic session. The target he said was for the University to be among the best African Universities.

He earlier told the new students that the purpose of the matriculation was to mark the formal introduction of fresh students into the norms of the University and to signal the end of the admission process.

The Registrar, Alhaji Sani Amin Ibrahim, had earlier invited the Deans of the faculties to present the matriculating students of their respective faculties.

Computation of Earned Allowances
