

BUK Holds Orientation For Fresh Students

Newly admitted students have been challenged to abide by the rules and regulations governing the University and desist from acts capable of denting their academic activities.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Rasheed, mni, who addressed the fresh students at the orientation ceremony organized by the University, tasked them to be committed to their studies in order to graduate with flying colours. He expressed confidence that the University was doing everything possible to ensure effective security services on the campuses.

In a lecture titled “Campus Security and Awareness: The Role of Students,” the Director of Security, Colonel Auwal Muhammad (rtd), said the students have enormous roles to play in complementing the management’s efforts to prevent crimes by assisting it with vital information.

The Ag. Director, Academic Affairs, Hajiya Fatima Binta Mohammed, said moral conduct and good character were part of the hallmark of graduation from the University, saying that a CGPA of 5.00 would be immaterial if they were not exercised.

Hajiya Fatima Mohammed, who delivered a lecture on Examinations Regulation and Scholarship, enjoined the new students to aspire for first class or good second class honours and be part of the beneficiaries of the University’s scholarship.

The Ag. Director cautioned the students to avoid any act of examination malpractice and other vices that might lead to expulsion.

The Academic Staff Union of Universities Chairman (BUK branch), Dr. Mahmud Lawan, in his lecture, “Academic Regulations and Student Unionism,” charged the new students to study the book of examinations regulations given to them in order to be acquainted with the laid down guidelines of the University standard regulations.

He advised them to be active members of the student union government and other student associations to interact and test politics at the grassroots.

In his paper, "Sports and Recreation in the University," the Chairman Sports Consultative Committee, Dr. B. A. Haruna, noted that the University has provided adequate sporting facilities for various sports meant for the relaxation of students.

Dr. Haruna emphasized that the University competed in different competitions organized by the Nigerian Universities Games Association (NUGA) and West African Universities Games (WAUG), adding that the University would parade its full scale athletes to represent it in all the games at the forthcoming NUGA Championship to be held in Ife.

He informed the students that Bayero University had just won the prestigious NUGA 5 - aside football trophy held in Lagos and called on potential athletes to register their names at the Sports Directorate.

Earlier, the Dean, Student Affairs, Professor Mohammed O. Bhadmus, in his opening remarks charged the new students to use the lectures maximally to guide and assist them throughout their studies.

JAIZ Bank Partners with BUK On Islamic Banking & Finance
