Equipment Worth N800m Installed At Faculty of Engineering

E quipment worth eight hundred million Naira have been purchased and are being installed at the laboratories of the Faculty of Engineering, the Dean of the Faculty, Dr. A. U. Alhaji, said.

Speaking at the orientation ceremony organized for new students by the Nigerian University Engineering Students Association (NUESA) on Thursday at the Faculty, the Dean said the faculty was the most equipped one in Nigeria, considering the one billion Naira allocated to it by the University Management for the installation of modern and high quality technological equipment through the Education Fund Trust (ETF) intervention fund.

Dr. Alhaji told the new students that the University was going through massive transformations of physical structures and academic programmes. He stressed that a new Department of Mechatronics would start academic activities very soon, while the Academic Development Committee has approved the Department of Chemical and Petroleum Engineering.

The Dean charged the fresh students to be occupied with academic activities throughout their 5-year study and engage in sporting activities for mental and physical fitness.

While urging the students to be law abiding and excel to get the University's scholarship, Dr. Alhaji challenged them to try hard to maintain the Faculty's excellent record of an examination- malpractice free faculty.

The University Librarian, Professor Lukman Diso, who was represented by Malam Garba Bello, called on the new students to register with the Library in order to gain access to numerous resources meant for them and to benefit with the ever expanding e-library services.

On his part, the President of NUESA, Comrade Usman Ahmad Aliyu,



advised the students to establish a common front by coming together as one family. He advocated for dedication, commitment, team work and prayer as keys to success.

Comrade Aliyu noted that the orientation marked the beginning of academic pursuits and an eye -opener for the new students.

The President commended his predecessors for their selfless services and avowed commitments towards uplifting the standard of NUESA.

Comrade Aliyu further tasked all and sundry to intensify prayers for perpetual peace to thrive in Kano and Nigeria at large.

Earlier in his welcome remarks, the Deputy Dean, Dr. Abdussamad U. Jibiya, gave a brief history of the Faculty, which he said was established 30 years ago with four Departments as the Faculty of Technology. He said it was recently renamed as Faculty of Engineering.

The Heads of the Departments of Agric Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, and the Sub-Dean, all spoke at the occasion.
