BUK Reassures Xtian Community of Safety

The University Management has reassured the Christian community of safety throughout the campuses and reiterated that the University would continue to maintain its stance as one of the most celebrated peaceful citadels of learning in Nigeria.

The Vice Chancellor. Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed. mni. made the assurance on Thursday when the President of the National Association of Nigerian Students, NANS. Comrade Muhammad Dauda. and other members of the association came to commiserate with the entire community over the recent attack in the University by some unknown gun men.

Professor Rasheed expressed the University's commitment and determination to continue to respect all the members of the faithful just as he told the NANS that Bayero University was proud to have its staff from all the 36 states in Nigeria and students from all the 774 local governments in the country. The Vice Chancellor further said the Management paid condolence visits to all the bereaved families and visited those injured at hospitals, saying the University lost some prominent and highly intellectual properties that for a long time served humanity diligently.

Earlier, the NANS President, Comrade Muhammad Dauda, expressed shock over what he termed an onslaught to the Nigerian students.

While condoling the University for the irreparable losses, the President urged the Federal government to be more proactive in protecting the lives and property of the people.

Kano Govt., Minister of Education Commiserate With BUK

The Kano State Governor, Dr. Rabi'u Musa Kwankwaso, and the Minister of Education, Professor Ruqayyatu Ahmed Rufa'i, have commiserated with the University Management and the entire members of the community over the attack on Christian worshippers that claimed some lives last week. The Minister, who visited the University along with the NUC Executive Secretary, Professor Julius Okojie, and was conducted round the affected areas by the members of the Governing Council and the Principal Officers of the University, said she was saddened by the unprovoked attack.

The Minister also visited the State Governor, Dr. Rabi'u Kwankwaso, to commiserate with the people of Kano over the unfortunate incident. She told the Governor that prayers should be intensified for permanent peace to thrive, saying without peace nothing would prosper.

The Governor on his part said the entire people of Kano were thrown into mourning when the incident occurred on the fellow Christian brothers and sisters.

Dr. Kwankwaso said he visited the victims at the hospital and directed for first class medical attention to be given to them.

The NUC Secretary, Professor Julius Okojie, and the Chairman of the Governing Council, Ambassador Muhammad Adamu Jumba, both expressed their displeasure over the attack and called on the federal government to beef up security in places of worship and institutions of learning. Earlier, the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Academic, Professor Mohammed Yahuza Bello, told the Education Minister, the NUC Secretary and the Chairman of the Governing Council that the Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Rasheed, cancelled his official assignment in Malaysia when he heard of the incident.

GuestHouseBoardDissolved,ANewOneReconstituted

The Board of the University Guest House was dissolved recently and a new one was reconstituted with the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academics), Professor Mohammed Yahuza Bello, the Registrar, Alhaji Sani Ibrahim Amin and Professor Murtala Sagagi to serve as the executive members.

Speaking, Professor Murtala Sagagi, who retained his position as the Managing Director, remarked that the dissolution of the Board was done in line with the laid down rules and regulations of the University management.

The Managing Director commended the former Board members for transforming the physical outlook and financial status of the Guest House and eulogized their commitment, hard work and exuberance during their tenure.



Professor Sagagi revealed that transformations massive were recorded to include a 250 seater conference hall and two suites and chalets, in addition to maintaining the existing standard rooms, as well as taking over the responsibilities of payments financial salarv and obligations.

The Managing Director stated that the statement of account of the Guest House stood at fourteen (14) million Naira and people owed it for an amount at little over 9million Naira.

The reconstitution of the new Board, which was held during the Annual General Meeting saw Professor Mohammed Yahuza Bello succeeding Professor Kabir Ahmad as the new Chairman of the Board.

The former Chairman, Professor Ahmed, expressed appreciation to the members for cooperating with him which yielded positive dividends. He assured that the new members given their competence and capabilities would fortunately transform the future of the Guest House.
