BUK Has Overcome Trauma of Attack – VC

Bayero University community has overcome the trauma of the attack on it earlier this year, but after the experience there is a higher level of tolerance by the different components within it.

This was the summing up of the situation by the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, while receiving members of the Reconciliation, Healing and Security Committee set up by the 19 Northern States Governor's Forum, who were recently in Kano to interact with communities affected by the prevailing insecurity situation.

The Vice Chancellor received the team along with Hajiya Naja'atu Muhammad and Professor G. D. Azare of the University Governing Council. The four strong team that came to the University led by the Chief Imam of Ankwa, Imam Salman Adam, included Prof. Sani Abdulkadir of BUK, Dr. Kole Shettima of the MacArthur Foundation and Reverend Sister Kathleen McGreevy of the Catholic Church.

Part of the Bayero University elders who attended the session included Professor F. A. Falola of the Geography Department; Prof. T. I. Oyeyi of the Parasitology Department; Professor of Soil Science, E. U. Essiet and a senior lecturer, Dr. L. F. Buba.

In the course of the interaction, there was a consensus that although the motive for targeting the University remains a mystery, the community is united in the realization that the enemy is outside targeting all within.

Moreover, the University elders expressed their appreciation over the warm brotherhood and solidarity shown to the affected persons following the incident.

NEW SUG President Designs Agenda For Students

BUK Muslim Forum's Public Lecture: "The Ethics of Work in Islam

The Bayero University Muslim Forum has conducted a public lecture titled: "The Ethics of Work in Islam" chaired by Dr. Musa Borodo of the Faculty of Medicine.

The lecture took place on Sunday 23rd December, 2012 at Theatre One, BUK Old Campus.

The Speaker at the public lecture, the Director, Institute of Continuing Education (I.C.E.), Dr. Salisu Shehu, discussed many important issues with regard to the guiding principles of

working class Muslims. In his speech, he drew the attention of employed Muslims to give their best in their places of employment. He also added that “Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) teaches us to give greater priority to our primary responsibility, or main job, before other pursuits”.

On her part, Dr. Amina Adamu of the Department of English and French, talked about the denotative meaning of the theme of the lecture (i.e. the dictionary meaning). She further explained that, “The employee is guided, or has certain rights, that an employer has to safeguard, so that he/she will be properly protected under Islamic law.” Dr. Adamu added that the Islamic principle of work also protects the employee to have a successful and cordial relationship with the employer.

The second discussant, Malam Usman Muhammad Shu’aib, of the Faculty of Law, discussed about Al-Ihsan “Muraqabatullah”. He stated a hadith says that we should worship Allah as if we can see Him. He added that in view of the above, public officers/civil servants do not need their employer or boss to come and

tell them what to do or what they are supposed to do.
