### 12<sup>th</sup> Council Holds Inaugural Meeting



The National Association of Nigerian Students (NANS) has stated the reasons behind the conferment of its 5 – Star General on the Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, *mni*, MFR, last week.

Reciting the speech of the NANS Secretariat on its position of the investiture at the Vice Chancellor's Committee room last week, the Director of Special Duties to the NANS Senate President, Adamu Kabir Matazu, said the student body had recently conducted its national Senate meeting at the Benue State University, Makurdi and members unanimously endorsed Prof. Rasheed as the best performing Vice Chancellor in Nigeria for the 2011/2012 academic session.

"Despite the leadership challenges in Nigeria, you have exemplified quality leadership and become a role model for the younger generation," he said.

Adamu Matazu added that the physical projects revolution and in BUK the introduction of entrepreneurial an programme, which prepares students to become self-reliant after graduation, has singled out Bayero University as the best prodigious exponent of better education in Nigeria.

The NANS, also decorated the Registrar, Sani Amin Ibrahim, MNIM, with its prestigious medal for his imbued commitments towards making education the toast of other professions.

In his acceptance speech, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Rasheed, said he was highly challenged by the Conferment of the 5 –Star General status by NANS. Prof. Rasheed stressed that the University, despite being recognized for its outstanding achievements, would not rest on its oars to deepen the quality of education, widen accessibility and broaden the frontier of knowledge.

The Vice Chancellor dedicated the award given to him to all the staff of the University for their dedication and sacrifices to ensure academic excellence.

### BUK Installs Anti-Plagiarism Software

Bayero University, Kano is installing an antiplagiarism software called Turn – It in order to check the menace of plagiarism in the University. Dr. Ado Dan'isa, Dean Faculty of Engineering, said this during a public lecture held on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2013 at the Faculty's conference room. He said that in near future, the work of all postgraduate students must pass through the software before they will be awarded degrees in their fields. He added that though the menace of plagiarism will not be totally erased, the software will help in reducing the level to a minimum.

Presenting a paper titled "Plagiarism in Teaching and Learning in Institutions of Higher Education in Nigeria", Engr. Sunusi Sani Adamu of the Department of Electrical Engineering said that somebody's work can be called a plagiarized work even if that person gives proper citation of source, but with that person's small contribution hidden inside the generous citation of other people's work.

Engr. Adamu identified two distinct types of plagiarism, direct and indirect. He said a student may be involved in a direct plagiarism which might be as a result of heavy workload, lack of self confidence, lack of understanding of the language being used to deliver lectures and poor planning.

On the other hand, he said the indirect plagiarism can be as a result of pressure or academic calendar disruption, which, he said, in most cases is the tradition of many Nigerian Universities.

He further said that in order to curtail the menace of plagiarism, the management must have a policy guideline on plagiarism, which could be part of the University's ethical policy. He added that to detect a plagiarized work, certain techniques must be used, like the ability of a lecturer to recognize a content submitted to him more than once, use of detection software and difference of style of writing.

The Dean, Faculty of Engineering, in his remarks after the lecture commended the presenter for a well researched paper, which he said was rich in content for the benefit of those that attended.

### Physically Challenged Vital To Nigeria's Devt. – VC

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, *mni*, MFR, has thrown his weight behind the educational empowerment of physically challenged persons and reiterated the University's resolve to support them.

Speaking when the Special Adviser to the 49 Governor of Kano on People with Disability paid a courtesy call last week, the Vice Chancellor said disabled persons have a big role to play towards national transformation, as they have been endowed with potential by God.

Prof. Rasheed expressed the University's readiness to employ physically challenged persons and give them admission should they meet the University's criteria.

"The University will try to employ a Desk Officer to attend to the needs and complaints of disabled persons and will advise the Student Union Government to create a portfolio that will cater for special students," he added.

Earlier, the Special Adviser, Usman Yusuf Dala, implored the University's assistance to extend its scholarship scheme to the physically challenged persons and employ them as staff of the University.

The Special Adviser noted that disabled persons have a role to play in the growth and development of the University. He identified 47 disabled students currently studying in the University and two lecturers.

Usman Dala further proposed for a joint seminar on the physically challenged persons and their role in nation building between his office and Bayero University.

The Vice Chancellor had already directed the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Administration),
Professor Sadiq Isah Radda, to collaborate
with the Special Adviser to fast track the seminar.

The SSANU team made a bright start after the break and could have equalized but Adamu Garba's prod with the outside of his boot whistled the ball to the waiting hands of ASUU goalkeeper.

Nura Garba over hit another cross past the onrushing Yusuf Sa'id before Adamu Garba wasted another good chance with a low shot straight at ASUU goalkeeper from close range.

Five minutes before regulation time, SSANU's Garba Zangina got a pass from Namadi Babangida and chipped in a low cross to unmarked Yusuf Sa'id, who made a simple spectacular tap in to the roof of the net and turned the score line to a 1 - 1 draw.

The match was played at the Old Campus field and attracted many academics and nonteaching staff, including the Bursar, Alhaji Buhari Musa, the former Bursar, Alhaji Abdu Gimba, Professor M. D. Sulaiman, Professor Mohammed O. Bhadmus, SSANU, ASUU executive members and Professor Lasun Emiola.
