



### **BUK's Phenomenal Development, Credit to TETFUND, Donors**

The Vice Chancellor of Bayero University, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed *mni*, MFR has attributed the phenomenal infrastructural development taking place in the University to the special intervention of TETFUND and other donor agencies.

Professor Rasheed spoke during the handing over ceremony to the University of the Interactive Learning Network (ILN) Project by TETFUND/NEPAD in his office on Tuesday, 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2013.

He said Bayero University may emerge the most productive beneficiary of TETFUND intervention among Universities in the country in the last 30 years, because the University embarked on a rebuilding and expansion strategy that saw the introduction of new science based programmes, as well as an increase of its faculties from 9 to 13.

The Vice Chancellor gave as examples the introduction of new departments of Forestry and Agro-Forestry, Fisheries and Food Science all in the Faculty of Agriculture; the upcoming Departments of Chemical and Petroleum, as well Communications Engineering, all in the Faculty of Engineering; and the creation of five Faculties to form the College of Health Sciences. He also announced the relocation of the Faculty of Law to the New Site next year,

saying that the desire of the University was to turn the Old Site into a science based campus with the creation of the Faculty of Pharmacy, thus completing BUK's transformation from a Humanities to a Science and Technology University.

Professor Rasheed said all these achievements were made possible by the quantum of support the University received from TETFUND and other donor agencies.

He said as part of its efforts to show appreciation for the support the University got from TETFUND, "we are going to publish a book on the impact of TETFUND on the University as it is being done for MacArthur Foundation," he revealed.

The Vice Chancellor said the ILN project that is being handed over to the University would strengthen its connectivity, such that the University will now be able to connect to all its campuses, in Dala and AKTH to the other two. He thanked TETFUND/NEPAD for its support to BUK and assured that the University management would do everything humanly possible to utilize the facility.

In his address, the Acting Executive Secretary of TETFUND, Malam Aliyu Na'iyah, said the project is a dedicated network for learning through which quality educational content and data could be developed, accessed and disseminated.

He said the funding of the project was approved in 2007 by Federal government

with the sole aim of setting-up a national learning infrastructure that will enable Nigerians access quality education content, implemented through NEPAD and TETFUND as the funding agency.

Malam Na'iya disclosed that the project was implemented in six selected institutions across the country made up of BUK, Kadpoly, Uni Abuja, Unilag, UI and UNN.

## **Academics, Practitioners Move To Save the Investment Climate**

Academics in Bayero University and business practitioners have fine-tuned strategies that could save the porous investment climate and promote efficient and productive entrepreneurship in Nigeria.

At the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarterly Round-Table Discussion organized by the Faculty of Social and Management Science (FSMS), on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2013 with the theme: *Investment Climate in Nigeria: Constraints and Possible Solutions*, some academics and business entrepreneurs from Kano discussed extensively on the theoretical perspective, constraints and prospects of business and investment.

Presenting a paper titled “Theoretical Constraints to Business Investment and their Consequences,” Professor Ummu Ahmed Jalingo said for a favourable investment climate to thrive, there was the need to address structural, attitudinal, political, socio-cultural and environmental constraints among others. She said the problems were teleguided by the political and institutional weaknesses,

which, if reversed, would make Nigeria a formidable hub for investment.

Dr. Bala Ado Kofar Mata, who delivered his lecture on “Doing Business and Regulatory Practices,” spoke on the issue of business licenses and registering properties, which he said was made difficult by the Land Use Act of 1978 that mandates every transfer of right of occupancy to secure the consent of a state governor. He conceded that favorable investment climate depends on a transparent judicial system in Nigeria.

Speaking on the practitioners’ perspectives, Alhaji Sa’idu Dattijo Adhama, who is a veteran entrepreneur in Kano State, said commerce and industry were faced with the challenge of unfavorable policies that hindered their transformation. He advocated for a strong political will to design and implement business friendly policies that will promote industrial growth.

On his part, Professor E. A. Olofin of the Department of Geography decried the insecurity and political instability as the major constraints to investment climate in Nigeria.

Earlier, the Dean, FSMS, Professor Adamu Idris Tanko, said the discussion was organized to bring together academics and other stakeholders in business and industry to brainstorm ideas that would be used as the basis for favourable investment climate and industrial transformation. He expressed gratitude to the Coordinator, Dr. Ahmad Tsauni, who initiated the program.

## Reasons For Business Failure in Nigeria – Adhama

Alhaji Dattijo Adhama who owns a textile factory in Kano has blamed some factors for the failure of Nigerian's enterprises. He spoke on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2013 at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round Table Discussion organized by the Faculty of Social and Management Sciences (SMS) New Campus of Bayero University.

Speaking at the session titled "Investment Climate in Nigeria Constraint and Possible stet," Alhaji Adhama explained that government policies such as the Structural Adjustment Programme (SAP), the IMF and World Bank policies and the lack of government support to the indigenous investors, are all factors that led to the failure of business enterprise.

According to him, the Nigerian government gives preference to foreign investors, which led to the closure of many factories, causing a high rate of unemployment in the country.

Alhaji Adhama also pointed out that as solution to these problems, government needs to promote and support indigenous enterprises and protect locally manufactured goods.

The foremost entrepreneur Adhama said that consumers, producers and the elites should unite and work as a team to ensure growth and the development of business enterprises in Nigeria.

Another speaker at the conference, Prof. Olafin also said that the attitude of government officials of accumulating money

meant for national projects and transferring it abroad without investing a kobo in the country and high insecurity, especially in the north, also contribute to the failure of business enterprises in Nigeria.

## Biochemistry Gets New H.O.D

Dr. A. M. Wudil has been appointed as the substantive Head of the Department of Biochemistry for two years commencing from 17<sup>th</sup> May 2013, according to a letter signed by the Vice Chancellor dated 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2013.

The letter urged the HOD to encourage, democratic participation by his colleagues in running the affairs of the Department.

## Guidelines for NHIS Refund

This is to bring to the notice of BUK staff registered with the NHIS at the University Clinic that they are entitled to a refund for drugs purchased. This is subject to the following guidelines:

- That the drug/test is not available in the Clinic at the time of the request/prescription.
- That the application for refund is accompanied by prescription/referral paper and receipts.
- That it should be within one month from the dates on prescription/request/referral.

Applicants/request for refund should be addressed to the Director of Health. Applicants should attach the documents mentioned above and should clearly write their NHIS and phone numbers.

Its terms of Reference are: (a) To conduct a compressive Student Audit; (b) To capture, in the list of the audited students: their Full Names, Programme of Study, Level, LGA, State or Origin (for Nigerians), and Nationality (for Non-Nigerians), Matriculation/Registration Numbers, JAMB Registration and/or Examination numbers and other details, as the case may be; and (c) To perform any other duty incidental to the assignment.

(b) **The Management Technical Committee on Staff Audit** is Chaired by the Director, General Administration. Other members of the Committee are: Deputy Director, PISU, MIS; Representative of the Director, CIT; Representative of ASUU; Representative SSANU; Representative of NAAT Representative of NASU; Raji Kazeem Ganiyu, Bursary Department; Ali Umar Yakasai, Directorate of Personnel Affairs; and Haruna Aliyu, Directorate of Personnel Affairs is a Member/Secretary.

Its Terms of Reference are: (a) To conduct a comprehensive Staff Audit University wide;

(b) To capture, in the data of the audited staff: Full Names, Staff Number, Rank, Salary Grade, GSM Number(s), LGA and State of Origin (for Nigerians), and Nationality (for Non-Nigerians), Qualifications (with evidences) and PFA; (c) To perform any other duty incidental to the assignment.
