We'll Subject 2016-2020 Strategic Plan Reports to Wider Consultation before Implementation - VC

Bayero University will implement the recommendations contained in the draft report of the 2016 – 2020 Strategic Plan submitted by the Draft Committee, because 'it will give us direction and enable us to know where we are coming from and where we are going to, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello has assured.

He, however, said in order to make the draft report all inclusive, it would be subjected to extensive scrutiny with a view to attracting more inputs from stakeholders before its full implementation.

The Vice Chancellor, who spoke when he received the draft report from the committee on Monday, 21st December, 2015 commended members of the committee for doing what he described as a done job well.

He said developing a well coordinated Strategic Plan was very crucial to development of any institution, saying that the unprecedented transformation that took place in BUK in the last few years was as a result of the development and full implementation of strategic plan.

Professor M.Y. Bello stated that in line with his administration's cardinal objectives of making the University a centre of excellence in teaching and research a dictum the committee gave priority in the development of the strategic plan, 'we have no option but to expose the report to wider contributions of members of the

University Management and Senate before presenting it to the Council for ratification. 'We shall use what we have to develop the University in the coming years,' he assured.

Earlier, presenting the report, the chairman of the committee, Professor Sagir Abbas, who is the Deputy Vice Chancellor, (Academics) thanked the Management for the confidence they have in them to develop the University's 2016 – 2020 Strategic Plan Draft.

He said in drafting the report, the committee took cognisance of the priority of the Vice Chancellor's mottor, which is excellence in teaching and research to develop nine-point agenda which if implemented would fulfill the desire of the present management.

Professor Sagir Abbas thanked members of the committee for their cooperation and understanding which he said led to the successful conclusion of the committee's assignment.

DUTIES

The Registrar, a Principal Officer, is the Chief Administrative Officer of the University, responsible to the Vice-Chancellor for the day-to-day administrative work of the University, except with regard to matters of finance for which the Bursar is responsible.

The person holding the Office of the Registrar shall, by virtue of that office, be Secretary to Council, the Senate, the Congregation and Convocation.

QUALIFICATION

Candidates should be graduates with a good honours degree from a recognized University. Possession of Postgraduate qualification and membership of professional bodies would be an added advantage. Candidates must have at least 15 (fifteen) years administrative experience, at least 10 (ten) of which must be at University level, and must be on the level of Deputy Registrar or higher. Candidates must be 60 years or below on appointment and must be Information and Communication Technology (ICT) compliant.
