



Congregational Parley Endorses Prof. Yahuza Bello as Preferred Candidate for the Post of VC

Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello has emerged as preferred candidate for the position of a new Vice Chancellor of Bayero University, Kano, after seventy percent (70%) of Congregation members elected him at the 48th Congregation (Special) among the eight other candidates that participated in the race, on Tuesday, 21st July, 2015.

Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello polled 834 votes to emerge as clear favorite for the 10th Vice Chancellorship position of the university and was ranked first by the Congregation, having scored the highest number of votes in a keenly contested election.

The election, which was scheduled to start at 9am, saw members throng the venue as early as 7am to be registered. The Musa Abdullahi Auditorium, venue of the election, was full beyond its capacity of one thousand, as many staff stood patiently to vote for their preferred candidate.

The Secretary of the Congregation and the Registrar, Sani Ibrahim Amin, MNIM, said by the Law, the Vice Chancellor was supposed to chair the parley, but due to his absence, as a result of

a delayed flight from Saudi Arabia, the congregation should appoint an acting chairman before the substantive one came. The Congregation later approved the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Administration, Professor Sadiq Isah Radda to oversee the affairs.

In his remark, the Chairman of the Standing Committee, Dr. Muhammad Babangida, told members of the congregation that it was a tradition of congregation members since 1993 to elect their preferred candidate, as part of the process for the appointment of a new Vice Chancellor.

He reminded members of the Standing Orders governing conduct at the meeting which among other things forbade any form of jeering, abusive language and heated debate.

Members of a Resolution Committee were elected to draft resolutions at the end of the meeting as follows:

1. Dr. I. K. Abdulsalam - *History*
2. Dr. Sulaiman Yar'adua - *Mass Communication*
3. Prof. Yusuf Adamu - *Geography*
4. Dr. Sunusi Mohammed Gaya - *Agronomy*
5. Dr. Abbas Jafaru Badakaya - *Mathematical Sciences*

The Congregation, also elected the following as members of the electoral committee:

1. Dr. Ado Malam Bello (Faculty of Law) - *Chairman*
2. Professor Ado Dan Isa (Faculty of Engineering) – *Member*
3. Professor Aisha Isma'il (Faculty of SMS) - *Member*

The Electoral Committee Chairman, Dr. Ado Malam Bello presented the eight candidates before the members of the congregation except Professor Duke Urhobo Ophori, who was expected to come from the United States of America, but was not able to.

The candidates were given ten minutes each to make their presentations and afterwards members of the congregation made comments and asked them several questions. The candidates responded to questions directed at them.

At the end of the election, the Electoral Committee with the assistance of members of the standing committee counted individual votes publicly and the result was presented as follows, in an alphabetical order:

The Chairman explained that the votes cast were as follows:

The Chairman of the election said a total of 1280 members registered their names but some

of them left before the election while others did not vote for any candidate.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Rasheed, who came after the election as a result of delayed flight he encountered in his way back in Nigeria from Saudi Arabia, expressed gratitude and thanks to the members of the Congregation for their maturity in the affairs of the university. "I thank each and every one of you for your patriotism and understanding and we hope in the next four weeks, which is three days to the end of my tenure, we will call another congregation to present a new Vice Chancellor to you. You have now indicated your interest through election and your input will be used accordingly", he said.

The Vice Chancellor then thanked the Registrar, who is the Secretary of the Congregation, the Standing Committee Chairman, Dr. Muhammad Babangida and the members of the committee for a job well done.

The Chairman of the Resolutions Committee, Professor Yusuf Adamu, who read the resolutions said at the end of the 48th Congregation Meeting held on Tuesday, 21st July, 2015, the Congregation resolved as follows:

1. That the Congregation listened to the presentations from various candidates for the positions of Vice Chancellor. The Congregation conducted the election for the ranking of candidates and they are ranked as follows:

2. The Congregation resolved to sustain the tradition of the parley for ranking of contestants for the position of Vice Chancellor.

3. The Congregation will forward the rankings to the Selection Board for further action.

EDL-FITR: New Campus Imam Calls for Adherence to Ramadan Lessons

The Imam of Bayero University New Campus, Professor Auwal Abubakar has enjoined Muslim Community to abide by the lessons of Ramadan fasting as solution to most of the problems.

Delivering the *Eid-el-Fitr* sermon last Friday 17th July, 2015 at the New Campus *Eid* Ground, he said this year's *Eid-el-Fitr* was among the few that were observed on Friday; Muslims he said are encouraged to observing both *Eid-el-Fitr* and Friday prayers, even though when they coincide, the Friday prayer is not considered obligatory.

Professor Auwal said endurance, assisting the less privileged, love, total submission to God and many other lessons taught by Ramadan have collectively served as blessings to the Muslim Community.

The Imam quoted the saying of the Holy Prophet that 'a person observing Ramadan fasting has two enjoyments, the first at the time of breaking the fasting and second in the hereafter when he meets with Almighty Allah.'

Professor Auwal urged Muslims to maintain the tempo of reciting the holy Qur'an, voluntary prayers, generosity, *Zikr* and such other good virtues being observed by Muslims during the month of Ramadan.

He appealed to the Muslims to guard against unhealthy utterances and actions detrimental to causing injury to others, saying further Muslims should learn to have patience on challenges that come their ways, as God has promised to test the faith of each and everyone.

The Imam reminded the wealthy individuals to remain resolute in sanitizing their wealth by way of giving *zakkat* just as the able ones have been ordained to give out *zakkatul-Fitr* at the end of every Ramadan fasting to comfort the less privileged in the society. He said Islam enjoined Muslims to pay visits to friends, relations, the sick persons and others with a view to making them happy.

Social Media Distorts Academic Performance – Idris Rogo

Frequent usage of social media has a negative academic impact on students, according to a research conducted by Malam Idris Salisu Rogo of the School of Continuing Education (SCE).

In a paper presented as part of Department of Education's Seminar Series, held on Thursday, 23rd July, 2015 at the School of Continuing Education, Malam Idris Salisu Rogo, who conducted a research, titled: the Effect of Social Media on the Academic Performance of Senior Secondary School Students of Ungogo Local Government Area of Kano State, revealed that there is a strong negative relationship between social media and academic performance among the secondary school students.

The researcher used survey research design and adopted Kreycie and Morgan (1971) table in determining sample size for the study. He also used a questionnaire titled Students Social Media Usage Scale (SSUS) to assess the frequency of social media usage by students and first term mathematics examination score was used to find out the academic performance of students.

The researcher administered 370 questionnaires to students drawn from a total population of 10, 058 students using stratified random sampling technique and that Pearson Product Moment Correlation Coefficient (PPMC) and Chi-square Test Independence were used to analyze the data.

According to the researcher, female students are found to be more active in the use of social media than their male counterparts.

Based on the findings, the researcher recommended that parents should monitor and supervise the activities of their children most especially in the areas of internet and social media. He added that parents have a role to play in preventing students of secondary school from using sophisticated handsets with internet facilities.
