ccreditation teams from the National Universities Commission (NUC) have arrived in Bayero University to accredit 25 programmes.

The teams converged on Monday, 27th November, 2016 at the Senate Chamber and were received by the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Academics, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, who formally welcomed them to the University, on behalf of the Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammd Yahuza Bello, who was away on official assignment. He said the university had made all the necessary arrangements for the smooth accreditation exercises.

## **CQS 5 Short Courses Commence**

The Centre for Qur'anic Studies, Bayero University, Kano, wishes to inform the public that it has kicked off its training programs. The programs which are at five iii. levels include:

- i. Basic Qur'anic Course: Is a program which is aimed at enhancing proficiency in Qur'anic recitation at Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced levels. The three categories are all for learners of Qur'anic recitation. The center has started teaching Basic Qur'anic courses. Members of staff of the University Community were among the pioneer candidates.
- ii. Ijazah Certificate: Is a special course for expert reciters of the Qur'an. It aims at giving certificate with an authentic Silsilah (chain of narration) linking to the prophet (SAW). The Programme has started with five candidates as the

first batch, the second batch consisting of 30 candidates will soon take off next week.

- iii. Certificate Course: Is known as Advanced Certificate in Quranic Studies has started with 102 candidates from Kano, Zamfara and Bauchi States. It is an intensive course in Qur'anic Sciences and Islamic Studies. This includes basic knowledge in Arabic and English Languages, teaching method and civic education.
- iv. Students' Tahfeez: Is a programme designed particularly for BUK students who are interested in memorizing the Qur'an. The program started with four BUK students. According to a release signed by Dr. Taufiq Abubakar Hussain on behalf of the Director, "the other remaining course i.e. Hifz Certificate will soon commence when the Instructor and the students are well set."

Upon completion of his NYSC in 1981 at UBA in Kano, he took up an appointment with the Kano State Planning and Budget Commission, rising to the rank of Assistant Chief Accountant and Head of the Commission in 1993.

His first appointment with BUK was in 1995, but within the same year he went back to the Commission as Acting Director, heading it until 2004, when he returned as Chief Accountant and Head of Budget and Project Unit of BUK. Bursary Department. He became a Deputy Bursar in 2001.

The late Alhaji Buhari Musa will be fondly remembered for his kindness, simplicity, generosity, professionalism and the fear of God.

Know more about typhoid fever:

- Typhoid fever is a sanitation related infection: which means proper sanitation expels it, while poor sanitation harbors it.
- It is an endemic disease next to malaria in Nigeria
- It is a bacterial disease caused by salmonella typhi of different species.
- Its mode of transmission is through contaminated food, water, vegetables and through contact with feaces of an infected person.
- Signs and Symptoms develop gradually at about one to two weeks after exposure to the infective agent (salmonella).
- The signs and symptoms include; fever that start low and increases daily which may be as high as 104.9f (40.5c), headache, body weakness, joint pain, diarrhea, vomiting, sweating, abdominal discomfort, constipation, loss of appetite, dry cough etc.
