



## 19<sup>th</sup> Professorial Inaugural Lecture: Prof Abdulrazaq Habib Calls for Dissemination & Translation of Medical Education

Professor Abdulrazaq G. Habib has advocated the need for a platform of dissemination, translation, publicity and consequent policy and practice changes, as well as public health intervention and implementation of medical education and research. He said where applicable, research findings should be translated on to an entrepreneurial platform.

Professor Habib, while delivering the 19<sup>th</sup> Professorial Inaugural Lecture on Thursday, 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 at Musa Abdullahi Auditorium titled: **Medicine, Science and Society: The Global Health Imperative**, said global health concerns cover both infectious and non-infectious diseases.

“In order to pre-empt what the global health challenges will be in the future, we need to predict so that we get prepared. To attempt, it is highly probable non-communicable diseases will or have already become important problems, but no less important emerging epidemic infections with pandemic potentials and antimicrobial resistance in one guise or the other will

threaten humanity,” he said.

Prof Habib, who is an Infectious Diseases Physician, Public Health Implementer and Epidemiologist, said there is the need for researchers and policy makers especially at international level to continue to invest and work on control of HIV/AIDS; Tuberculosis and Malaria vaccines; unsafe water and improve sanitation. He added that there is the need to address/curtail intake of excess salt, excess sugar and ethanol and tobacco and find innovative ways of addressing under-nutrition, unhealthy consumption and other food related maladies.

Earlier, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, who was represented by the University Librarian, Dr. Musa Auyo, said inaugural lectures became a global practice to accomplish the effort of Professors. He said the topic of the lecture was apt and the presenter was an astute academic and intellectual scholar of high repute.

## Workshop on Using Modern Tools for Teaching, Learning & Assessment to Cover all Staff in Future - VC

In her remark, the resource person, Mrs Bekky Kajoh, said the week-long training workshop was a wonderful experience for her, as the participants had paid

maximum attention. She said that she had taught them many aspects of developing electronic contents, such as creating synchronized presentations, screen castomatic, using the smart board to develop e-content and web-based tools for collaboration.

Mrs. Kajoh said she was happy that all the participants were able to create content and develop websites, saying that knowledge nowadays was being driven by innovation and technology. She expressed optimism that all the participants deserved the certificates given.

Earlier, in his remark, the Director, Centre for Dryland Agriculture (CDA), Professor Jibrin M. Jibrin, said the training workshop, aimed at training the participants to use technology tools to shift from the conventional face-to-face lecture style of delivering content and assessing to a smart classroom, was interactive and student centered.

Bayero University contingent participating in the on-going 25<sup>th</sup> edition of Nigeria Universities Games Association (NUGA), tagged, 'Makurdi 2017' has so far won a total of seven medals; three Gold, two Silver and two Bronze.

Two of the Gold medals were won in athletes by Sharon Ajuji in the 5,000 and 3,000 meters long race category respectively. The third Gold was won in the 81 kilogramme judo category by Abdurrahman Ejeba Muhammad. Two Silver medals were won one each in Judo and Taekwondo; another two bronze medals were won each in Judo and shot-put respectively.

Meanwhile, the female basketball team would be meeting Benue State University later today (Thursday) in the final of the female Basketball category to decide who goes with the Gold medal. The female Basketball team reached the final stage after defeating Obafemi Awolowo University (OAU) female team by 43 to 36.

Meanwhile, the Director of Sports, Professor Rabi'u Muhammad had urged the team to remain focused and go for Gold Medal in the remaining games in order to justify the support and encouragement given to the team by the management. He congratulated the team for winning seven medals so far, assuring them that 'incentives await those who win gold medals.'

He reminded them of the need to maintain their good conduct which they displayed during the opening ceremony of the competition last Saturday and which had also earned the BUK contingent commendation from both the NUGA officials and the host university.

## Kano State Government Accepts B.Sc (Ed) Health Education

The Kano State Government has answered the calls of hundreds graduates of B.Sc (ED) Health Education working with the State Ministry of Health, Hospital Management Board and Primary Health Care Management Board on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2017. The State Government complied with the Federal Government directives in a circular (HCSF/EPO/ERIS/VOL1/2) released on 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2008, which approved the inclusion of B.Sc Health Education registered with Environmental Health Officers Registration Council (EHORECON) as an additional entry qualification into Environmental and Community Health Cadre.

A statement signed by Dr. A.F. Alhassan of the Department of Physical and Health Education, said the

Circular released by the state government clearly stated that the entry point for a fresh university graduate is GL 08 and terminates at GL 16. Meanwhile, any holder of B.Sc Health Education with evidence of registration with EHORECON is eligible for lateral conversion into Environmental and Officers' Cadre.

Dr. Alhassan encouraged all the graduates of Health Education from BUK and other sister universities to register with EHORECON for professional recognition.

“May this development be the beginning of success and progress to our young and noble profession in the state and the country at large”, Dr. A.I. Hassan of the Department of Physical and Health Education, who provided the above information, prayed.
