



## VC Commends Staff Unions for Calling-off Strike

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, has commended the three non-teaching staff unions for calling-off their 5-day warning strike.

The Joint Action Committee (JAC) of National Association of Academic Technologists (NAAT), Senior Staff Association of Nigerian Universities (SSANU) and Non Academic Staff Union of Educational Institutions (NASU) had on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 embarked on a 5-day warning strike over the failure of the Federal Government to implement the 2009 agreement with the unions.

The Vice Chancellor, who received the three unions on Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 in his office said staff unions were partners in progress and expressed the university management's determination to continue to work with the unions for the betterment of the university.

Earlier, the Chairman of SSANU, Comrade Haruna Aliyu, who spoke on behalf of the unions told the Vice Chancellor that they received a directive from their respective national executive councils to call-off the strike because federal government had shown its total commitment to implement the 2009 agreement with the staff unions.

## BUK Awards N6.24m Scholarship to 156 Top Scoring Students

The Vice Chancellor, Prof. Yahuza M. Bello, has approved that 156 best students with the highest CGPA at their Levels from across all the departments in the University be awarded N40,000 scholarship each, payable immediately. The scholarship totaling N6.24 million is to be paid to each beneficiary upon the presentation of an ID card and awards letter to the Bursary Department, according to a statement issued by Amina Umar Abdullahi, Deputy Registrar in the Directorate of Examinations, Admissions and Records (DEAR).

It would be recalled that, apart from the above *BUK scholarship for best students*, there are five other categories of scholarship, coordinated by the Office of the Dean Student Affairs, for the benefit of BUK students, including: (1) Scholarship awards from different organizations in Nigeria, Total, Agbami and Shell scholarships for Engineering, Medical and Science students; (2) PTFDF scholarship for Engineering Students; (3) Etisalat scholarship; (4) Federal scholarships; (5) Jifatu and Azman's scholarships for indigent students.

## BUK will Lead in Research and Scholarship

An erudite scholar and a Professor of Political Science from the University of Hartford CT, United States of America, Professor Adryan Wallace, was optimistic that Bayero University would in the very near future assume leadership position in the area of research and scholarships not only among Nigerian Universities, but also among globally rated universities.

Professor Wallace, who made the observation in an interview with the *Bulletin* shortly after a private audience with the Vice Chancellor on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>

January, 2017, stated that she was impressed by the number of research institutes in the University.

She said massive amount of investment could be seen in research and scholarship development, which according to her would undoubtedly transform Bayero University into a flagship in research exploits.

Professor Wallace said of all the centres, she was excited about Centres for Renewable Energy and Gender Studies, adding that “we will like to exploit



areas of collaboration with these centres particularly the Centre for Gender Studies so that together we can help address the inequality that women and girls are facing not just in academia, but also in the greater community.”

The erudite scholar said she was in BUK to deliver a paper titled: **'From Brexit to President Elect Trump: The rise of Extremist Movements in Western Europe and North America,'** at the Political Science Departmental Seminar Series.

She also described the anti-corruption war of the Buhari administration as “a necessary evil,” which must be supported by all, saying that 'from evidences on ground, the present Nigerian government had taken the bull by the horn, all that was needed is for Nigerians to rally round him,' she remarked.

Professor Wallace stated that the 2015 general election in Nigeria was a great effort by Nigerians, particularly by Professor Muhammad Attahiru Jega, the then INEC Chairman to bring back Nigeria's integrity and credibility in its electoral system as well as among the comity of Nations.

On the recent election in the United States, Professor Wallace admitted that it was a very difficult period for

them (Muslims), because, according to her, instances abound where Muslims were targeted, acts of violence committed against them and their places of worships attacked and damaged. All these were happening because of the type of campaigns ran by Mr. Donald Trump, which used Islamophobia and exploited the ignorance of a sizeable number of Americans.

On the issue of extremism, the erudite scholar said it was unfortunate that “we often talk about extremism especially globally in the news and link it with Islam, but the fact is that people are not talking about the nationalist (extremist) movement which are more ferocious that are happening in Sweden, Germany, the UK and even in the US.”

She said since the 2001 September 11<sup>th</sup> World Trade Centre incident, the “global war on terror” created a particular narrative around “terrorism,” which unfortunately tended to disproportionately examine groups which distort and manipulate religion specifically Islam, while leaving other forms of extremism not centred solely around religion less visible. “It is imperative that all forms of extremism are examined in an effort to combat their negative impact particularly when the efforts of such movements are to mainstream their ideological goals within normal political discourse.”

## BUK Gets Space Weather And Atmospheric Laboratory

**T**he Center for Atmospheric Research (CAR) in collaboration with Bayero University Kano has established a joint laboratory for Space Weather and Atmospheric Physics Laboratory Swap in the Department of Physics.

The Director and Chief Executive CAR, Professor Babatude Rabi, represented by Assistant Chief Science Officer and Project Manager of Tropospheric Data Acquisition Network (TRODAN), Najeeb Yusuf, confirmed the new laboratory when he presented the Campbell Scientific Automatic Weather Station to the Vice Chancellor Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello at the VC's conference room on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2017.

The equipment has nine sensors, which measure nine parameters ranging from the measurement of air temperature, relative humidity, barometer pressure, solar radiation, rain rate, wind speed, wind direction, soil Temperature and soil moisture.

The Campbell Scientific Automatic Weather Station store the data of each parameter every hour and stores such data for the period of one year to be used for further enquires and research from different fields (Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Agriculture, Earth Science, Geography, Engineering) among others. The equipment makes use of solar power and has a valid life of 8 years.

CAR has installed 18 of these instruments in the country, with two in North West of the country. The first was set up in the Usmanu Danfodiyo University Sokoto and the second in Bayero University Kano.

CAR was established in January 2013 as a research and development arm of the National Space Research and Development Agency (NASRDA) committed to research and capacity building in atmospheric and related sciences located in Kogi State university campus, Anyigba.
