# Scholarship: Alumni Disburse N1.2m Cheques to Indigent Students

he Bayero University's Alumni Class '92 has given scholarships amounting to N1, 240,000.00 to some 31 indigent students. Presenting the cheques to the benefitting students at the Board Room of Students Affairs Division on Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2018, the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Administration), Professor Adamu Idris Tanko, commended the efforts of the Alumni.

He said that education was very expensive nowadays and, therefore, everybody should supplement the efforts of the government. According to him, the burden was too huge for government alone to shoulder, saying that Alumni and public spirited individuals should come in to assist. In particular, he commended the patriotic zeal of BUK's Class of '92, pointing out that it took a responsible person to remember and appreciate those who had supported him at the most critical time of his

development.

Earlier, the representative of the BUK Class '92 Alumni, Dr Hajara Umar Sanda, the Deputy Dean of Student Affairs said the forum tasked its members to make contributions as part of its desire to pay back what the society and government had done to them.

Dr. Sanda, who teaches at the Department of Mass Communication, explained that the donations were in two categories. She disclosed that the general Alumni of Class '92, including Mass Communication '92, sponsored 25 students while a separate additional contribution was made by Mass Communication Class '92 to take care of six additional students, bringing the total number of the beneficiaries to 31. She said the award was to take care of the registration fees of the benefitting students and token stipends to support their stay during the semester.

# Students' Educational Trust Fund Underway

The Bayero University Students Union Government has proposed the establishment of a students' Educational Trust Fund Account (SETFA) as part of a deliberate policy aimed at assisting indigent students.

Under the arrangement, each registered student of the University will contribute the sum of N200 during registration period yearly, which will be deposited into a special account to take care of some students with peculiar problems.

The Dean of Students Affairs, Professor Isma'ila Zango,



who disclosed this on Tuesday, 9th January, 20-18 at the Conference Hall of the Students Affairs Division explained that other staff unions of the University had equally shown their intention to participate in the new programme.

Already, he said members of the Academic Staff Union of Universities (ASUU) BUK branch, had agreed to be part of the contributors under the Students Educational Trust Fund Programme.

Professor Zango, however, urged the remaining unions, SSANU, NASU and NAAT, to follow suit, explaining that the project would go a long way in alleviating the suffering of students who cannot afford to pay their registration fees.

According to him, the idea was advanced in view of the frequent requests for suspension of studies often made by some students with financial difficulties.

> The Dean commended the foresight of the Executives of the Students Union Government for supporting the Student Affairs Division's idea of initiating the programme. It could be recalled that each year the University sets aside a huge amount of money to pay scholarship to some students in addition to the funds awarded by some philanthropic members of the society.

> The Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, who was represented by the DVC (Administration), Professor Adamu Idris Tanko, expressed his appreciation of the exemplary gesture by the Class '92 Alumni and asked other Alumni to emulate.

Responding on behalf of the beneficiaries, Mr. Victor Kelechi, a Level Two student from Department of English and Literary Studies, expressed his profound appreciation of the gesture, which, he said, had come handy. "I have almost given up as to the

continuation of my studies due to my inability to raise the registration fees. But now, I can comfortably continue with my studies. We are indeed very grateful", he concluded.



Dr. Rasheedah Liman of the Department of Theatre and Performing Arts, Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria while shedding more light, she disclosed that out of 125 proposals submitted nationwide for this year's activities 19 were selected including the one submitted from ABU Zaria that would be showcase in Zaria, Kano and Abuja been strong constituencies.

She said the events will feature history and how it affects the black race, adding that two Professors from America are coming to interact with other participants. She disclosed that the contingent would come to Bayero University to conduct a public lecture and performance.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello. congratulated them for winning the entry on Black History Month which he said is not surprising considering the strong hold of Theatre and Performing Arts in ABU.
