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Director, CAMRAT Suggests Specialized Training to Reduce Maternal Mortality Rate By Fausat A. Opayemi

he Director, Centre for Advanced Medical Research and Training (CAMRAT), Professor Hadiza Shehu Galadanci, has called for the need to give specialized training through research to reduce the maternal mortality rate.

She made this call while leading a delegation of Association of Fetomaternal Specialists of Nigeria (AFEMSON) on a courtesy call on the Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, on Tuesday, 17th of July, 2018 at the VC's Committee Room.

According to her, members of the association were in Kano State for the 2nd Scientific Conference and Annual General Meeting, with a scientific packaged session on the use of new technologies, such as Doppler machine, for their trainees on the major causes of maternal mortality and how it could be reduced to the barest

minimum.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, in his response, expressed happiness that some of the scientific sessions would take place at Centre for Advanced Medical Research, headed by Professor Galadanci, who has always been in the fore front to eradicate infant and maternal mortality. He assured the delegates of the University's willingness to support the association.

The Vice Chancellor said that the conference would enable members to share common practice and enable key personnel master the new technology to combat maternal mortality.

Professor Bello told the delegates that the University was open to criticisms, which could make it improve on what it had achieved.

The World Bank under its Africa Centres of Excellence (ACEs) will support university centres to specialize in specific areas as regional centres of excellence. The new call, dubbed: "ACEIII" or "ACE Impact" invites proposals from universities in Africa to address the continent's development challenges through skilled manpower and appropriate technologies.

Bayero University is developing proposals in five areas: Renewable Energy and Development; Population Health and Policy; Biotechnology and Industrial Research for Development and Innovative Teaching and Learning. The Centre for Dryland Agriculture (CDA) is applying for renewal of its ACE project.

Each of the four new proposals could win up to \$5 million,


while the proposal for renewal of CDA's ACE Project could be up to \$2 million.

The Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) and its partners (the European Union (EU Delegation to Nigeria and ECOWAS), European Centre for Electoral Support (ECES) and the Youth Initiative for Advocacy Growth and Advancement (YIAGA) invite members of the University Community to join them in the programme, active driver of the 'Youth Vote Count' Voter Education Campaign proposed to hold on **Tuesday 7**th **August, 2018** from 9:00am at Mahmud Tukur Theatre Old Campus.

A statement signed by the Chairman, INEC, Professor Mahmoud Yakubu, noted that the ultimate goal of the campaign was to increase the level of youth participation and boost citizens' trust and confidence in the electoral process. This is part of activities hosted in furtherance of the Commission's effort to deepen the participation of youth in the electoral process ahead of the 2019 General Elections.

The youth-specific voter education campaign aims at mobilizing young people, especially first-time voters, to exercise their franchise by registering to vote in the 2019 General Elections. The programme will focus on the Continuous Voter Registration (CVR), collection of Permanent Voter' Card (PVC), the importance of

tolerance and non-violence in electoral competition and other issues likely to undermine the participation of students/youth in elections. It will also provide an opportunity for students to engage with the INEC leadership and policy-makers on matters related to elections and citizen's participation in the electoral process.

The campaign is designed for students in selected tertiary institutions across the six geo-political zones of the country and provides a platform for instilling the values of patriotism, volunteerism, civic participation and opting for alternative or different opinions in young people. The maiden programme was held at the University of Abuja on 3rd May, 2018, followed by the second in Lagos on the 26th June, 2018.

Students will be exposed to information on the electoral process and how young people can engage the electoral and political processes. It will feature panel discussions, community outreach activities, social media campaigns and volunteers' recruitment. It is expected that the program will increase the enthusiasm of young people to engage in the electoral process by participating in the Continuous Voter' Registration and the collection of PVC's.
