BUK to Partner With CIBN in Promoting Banking Industry in Nigeria – Vice Chancellor By Abubakar Yusuf

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza On the Chartered Institute of Bankers of Nigeria, the Bello said Bayero University was ready to work with the Chartered Institute of Bankers of Nigeria (CIBN) to ensure Nigeria get qualified people that will work in the Banks of the country.

Professor Yahuza Bello disclosed this when the President of the Chartered Institute of Bankers of Nigeria paid him a courtesy visit in his office on Wednesday, 21st March, 2018.

He said even though it was recently that the University had gotten a separate department of Banking and Finance, the University has produced many Bankers who read courses like Accounting, Economics or Business Administration and other Banking related courses.

Vice Chancellor said the University had created International Institute of Islamic Banking and Finance (IIIBF) in 2012 in its effort to encourage and develop non- interest Banking most especially in the Northern part of this country.

Vice Chancellor commended its effort in ensuring only qualified persons work in Nigeria's Banks. He promised that the University would do everything humanly possible to ensure the Institute achieve the desired goal.

On his part, the President of the Chartered Institute of Nigeria, Dr. Segun Ajibola, commended Bayero University for its contribution towards the development of Banking and Finance not only in the country but in the whole world. He said if the University and the Institute joined hands together, Nigeria would have enough qualified people that will work in the country's Banks.

One of the duties of the Institute, according to him, is to enforce that only people that are members of the institute, work in the banks of the country. He said very soon the Institute would see to the removal of its nonmembers who work in Nigerian Banks.

Dr. Segun called on the University to collaborate with the institute in the airing of the institute's flagship radio programme "You and Your Banker" on the University's radio station.

Health Advise on Cerebral Spinal Meningitis (CSM)

- caused by the bacteria Neisseria Meningitides.
- Bacterial meningitis is an infection of the meninges, the thin covering of the brain and spinal cord.

- 4. The bacteria are transmitted from person to person through droplets of respiratory or throat secretions from carriers. Close and prolonged contact such as kissing, sneezing or coughing on someone, or living in close quarters (such as dormitory, sharing eating or drinking utensils) with an infected person (a carrier) – facilitates the spread of the disease.
- 1. Cerebral Spinal Meningitis (CSM) is most often 5. The most common symptoms are a stiff neck, high fever, sensitivity to light, confusion, headaches and vomiting.
 - 6. Avoid overcrowding in residential houses, public transport systems, working places, barracks, camps, schools, places of worship, places of leisure and indeed any public or residential gathering.
 - 7. Ensure personal hygiene and also reduce or eliminate direct contact by discouraging overcrowding.
 - Moreover, seek immediate care if you or someone in your family has meningitis symptoms mentioned above.
