The New Deputy Vice Chancellors (Academics and Administration), Professor Adamu Idris Tanko and Professor Haruna Wakili, respectively assumed duty on Thursday, 4th October, 2018 after handing over their former offices to their predecessors with the promise to render their unalloyed commitment for the development of the University.

The outgoing Deputy Vice Chancellor, Academics,

Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, had handed over to Professor Adamu Idris Tanko, few minutes after the latter handed over his office to Professor Haruna Wakili, the former Director of Mambayya House, Aminu Kano Centre for Democratic Studies.

Bayero University *Weekly Bulletin* recalled that the 13th Governing Council at its 5th meeting held on Wednesday, 8th August, 2018 approved their

appointments with effect from 4th October, 2018 each for a period of two years upon the outcome of the selection exercise carried out by the Senate at its 365th meeting held on Wednesday, 25th July, 2018.

The new Deputy Vice Chancellor, Administration, Professor Haruna Wakili, equally handed over the affairs of his vacated office to the former and pioneer Dean of Faculty of Social Sciences, Professor Isma'ila Zango, shortly after the Faculty had organised a grand reception for the latter at the Board Room of the Faculty.

All the Deputy Vice Chancellors have expressed their readiness and willingness to contribute to the development of the University, appealing to all the staff to support the management in carrying out its duties to move the University forward.

The former Deputy Vice Chancellor, Academics, Professor Abbas, on Wednesday 3rd October, 2018 expressed gratitude to the Almighty Allah for his safe landing. He thanked the former Vice Chancellor of Bayero University and Executive Secretary of the National Universities Commission, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, for bringing him into the university administration.

Professor Abbas further thanked the Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, who mentored

him when he assumed duty as Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academics) on 25th March, 2015. He said the Vice Chancellor had put him through with advice for almost six months. "I relied on him for advice, I thank him for my first and second terms in office. It was at his discretion to renew my second term," Professor Abbas disclosed.

The former Deputy Vice Chancellor thanked other management staff and the entire staff members of the University. He described Bayero University family as brothers and sisters, who united to work as a team for the development of the University. He added that the relationship between the teaching and non-teaching staff was cordial.

He said holding the office of Deputy Vice Chancellor would never be an easy task, especially when the Vice Chancellor was away on another official engagement, as the task would become tedious and cumbersome. CDA Holds 3rd Int'l Conference on Drylands to Address Resource Conflicts, Climate Change

The Centre for Dryland Agriculture (CDA) in collaboration with ICRISAT and International Institute of Tropical Agriculture (IITA) has conducted its 3rd International Conference with the theme: **Resource Constraints, Conflicts and Changing Climate in the Drylands: Options for Attaining Sustainable Development Goals SDGs.**

The Conference brought together scientists, researchers, development partners, industries, policy makers, farmers, public and private organizations from across the globe to examine how the SDG's could be attained in the drylands in the face of resource scarcity, climate change and the emerging conflicts. "It is also aimed at examining how public policies, research and development programmes will contribute in ensuring food security and in the attainment of the SDG's," said the Director, Centre for Dryland Agriculture, Professor Jibrin M. Jibrin at the opening ceremony on Tuesday, 25th September,

2018.

The Deputy Governor of Kano State, Dr. Nasir Yusuf Gawuna, advocated the need for creating viable and

effective blue-print by all relevant stakeholders, that would engender food sufficiency and promote

sustainable agricultural development.

Dr. Gawuna, who declared the conference open, said the theme was apt and timely, stressing that emerging issues such as conflict between farmers and pastoralists, insufficient/poor grazing reserves and the devastating effect of climate change should be critically addressed.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello challenged experts to proffer solutions to the threat of climate change, to competition for natural resources and to conflicts in dryland areas of Sub-Saharan Africa.

“I have no doubt that Universities have important roles

to play in helping governments and other stakeholders to implement the noble objectives of the SDG's by sharing their knowledge and experiences,” said the Vice Chancellor.

Goodwill messages were delivered at the opening ceremony by Dr. Peter Craufurd (CIMMYT); Bernard Vanlauwe (IITA); Prof Mahmud I. Daneji (MD KNARDA) and Dr. Alpha Kamara (IITA), among others.

The Managing Director said that Triumph Publishing Company had five titles, *Daily Triumph*, *Sunday Triumph*, *Weekly Triumph*, *Albishir* and *Alfijir*. He said the company had some distinctive features, having been the only newspaper organisation in the country that was producing an *Ajami* newspaper.

He solicited the support of federal and state governments, private organisations, individuals and NGO's in helping the organisation to regain its lost glory, so that its titles could reach all the Northern and Southern states. He said when he was appointed to serve as Managing Director in 2017 he was given the mandate to make the newspapers national.

Alhaji Ibrahim commended Kano State Governor, Dr. Abdullahi Umar Ganduje, for his foresight of not only

reopening the company but also of providing all the support needed by its Management to bring back the company's lost glory. He said the Governor always responded to the requests of the organisation. He said that the focus now was to obtain Direct Image printing machines, which, he said he was optimistic that the Governor would help in that direction.

The Editor of *Daily Triumph*, Malam Musa Ahmad Tijjani, expressed confidence that the Triumph's titles will satisfy the yearnings of their teeming customers, with the Editor-in-Chief, the Editor, Daily; Malam

Aliyu Umar, Editor of *Albishir* and Ghali Mujitaba, the Editor, *Alfijir*, and other experienced staff redeployed to work in the company.

He traced the history of Triumph Publishing Company to 1980, when the first civilian Governor of Kano State, Alhaji Muhammadu Abubakar Rimi, established the company, in which *Albishir* and *Alfijir* were jointly published in 1981 and in June 1983 the *Sunday Triumph* came onboard and at a later time, the *Daily Triumph* was introduced.
