## We Must Globalise the Operations of our Media ... Professor Pate

he only way to ensure effective communication strategy and checkmate the excesses of fake news in the conventional media is by way of globalizing their operations, a Professor of Media and Society, Professor Umar A. Pate, has said.

Speaking on live Tuesday Live, an NTA Network programme, on Tuesday, 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2020, Professor Umar Pate, who is also the Dean of School of Postgraduate Studies, said however, one sure way of improving the operations of our local media organizations was for government to upgrade the facilities as well as to recruit the best hands to manage them.

"We should be more strategic in our approach to handling the media organizations. As a way of building trust between the people and the media especially the public media, it is necessary for us to globalise the operations of the local and at the same time localize the global media," he opined.

According to him, government must equip the media stations with a state-of-the art facilities in addition to having well trained and the right personnel. By so doing, the media would then present the citizens with critical minds in their programmes rather than propagandized activities which often lead to distrust on the media by the members of the public.

Turning to the issue of fake news which has become prevalent nowadays, Professor Pate hinged the blame on the censorship on the use of public media especially on denying the opposition to have access to such

#### organizations.

He noted that with the accessibility of internet occasioned by social media, conventional media may have a greater role to play, particularly in allowing the opposition to use their facilities."The media must be open to public. When you deny the opposition the state media, they can now switch over to social media and fabricate all sorts of fake news, which will in turn be dangerous to the society,"he said.

He also suggested that government must develop a rapid response mechanism in respect of anything so as not to allow rumours to thrive. "Government officials



must always be active by responding rapidly to any issue before it goes out of hand. So long as the government remains secretive, it will be disastrous to our collective interest," Prof. Pate added.

### We Established Sa'ad College as Part of Community Service ...Says Professor Sagir Abbas

The Director of Sa'ad College, Kano, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas has said that the College was principally established as part of community service as well as giving contribution to the development of education in the society.

He spoke on Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 when he received the leadership of the Parent Teachers Association (PTA), of the College when they paid him a congratulatory visit over his appointment as the 11<sup>th</sup> Vice Chancellor of Bayero University, Kano, explaining that, since schools establishment, the management had not increased its fees.

"Our desire was to give to the society something that it will treasure forever. It is our conviction that education is the best gift to any human being. Any society that negates education sector to the background, it is bound to fail. Our school is among the best here in the state, yet our fees remain the least compared to the quality and standards we placed the College," he declared.

According to Professor Abbas, since its establishment about a decade ago, Sa'ad College has never increased its fees. This is due to the fact that our mission is not to exploit or make quick riches, but rather to give our token contribution to the well being of the society by giving good and quality education to our teeming youth.

He also revealed that all staff of the College were placed on a special pension scheme in which every month, the management set aside 15% of staff salary as a monthly contribution for each staff which would be given after leaving the service of the College, retirement or death as the case may be.

The Vice Chancellor commended the PTA for the visit and charged them not to compromise in standards and quality.

Earlier, the Chairman of the Parent Teachers Association (PTA) of the Sa'ad College, Kano Alhaji Aminu Nasir Zubair, said they were in the office to congratulate the new Vice Chancellor on what he termed as a well-deserved appointment.

He took time to extoll the good virtues of Professor Abbas, where he said members of Bayero University community were lucky to have this man of honour, humility and respect as the new leader. He described him as one of the finest academics who were committed to making the university great.
