he University's Governing Council at its 12<sup>th</sup> regular meeting held on Saturday, 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2021, approved the tenure extension of the Registrar, Hajiya Fatima Binta Mohammed for another one year.

A letter signed by the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, said the extension was in recognition of the exceptional performance of the Registrar in her five years on the seat.

"The 13<sup>th</sup> Governing Council at its 12<sup>th</sup> regular meeting held on Saturday, February 13<sup>th</sup> 2021 invoked Section 2(4) of the Miscellaneous Provision (Amendment) Act 2010, which provides for a possible extension of the Registrar's tenure for a further period of one year only, upon satisfactory performance," the letter reads in part.

Professor Sagir Abbas said the extension would take effect from 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2021 to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022. He commended the spectacular performance of the Registrar towards the transformation of the Registry

Department in particular and the University in general, which stood her out.

It could be recalled that, the Registrar, Hajiya Fatima Binta Mohammed was appointed for a five-year term in February 2016. She took over from Dr Sani Ibrahim Amin.

During her tenure, she introduced a number of policies which were instrumental to the numerous developments recorded in the University including massive training of members of staff, including fellowships for PhD's and other academic programes, encouraging mentoring of younger staff by the senior ones as well as prompting promotion and recognition of excellence and hard work.

During her tenure, she instilled discipline amongst staff as well as encouraged seniority and pursuance of due process in all affairs amongst staff thereby ensuring hardwork and efficiency in service delivery.

### **EMERGENCE OF STRAY ANIMALS IN THE UNIVERSITY CAMPUSES**

This is to bring to the notice of members of the university community that any member of staff who rears livestock in the campus should urgently tame their animals as the management has resolved to apprehend any straying animals forthwith.

A circular issued by the Security Division and signed by the Director, Security, Alhaji Abdulyakin Ibrahim, said the decision was necessary in view of the menace caused by the straying animals including damages to plants, vehicles

and other university property.

It warned that security operatives had been mandated to henceforth apprehend any straying animals seen in the campuses and that apprehended animals could only be released to the owner upon payment of damages and/or at the last resort, the Management may be compelled to dispose off the apprehended straying animals where appropriate.
