



## Senate Approves Adjustment of Second Semester Undergraduate Academic Calendar

The University Senate has approved an adjustment to the 2020/2021 undergraduate Second Semester Academic Calendar.

This was contained in a resolution of the 384<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Senate chaired by the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas held on Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 at the Convocation Arena, New Campus.

A statement signed by Amina Umar Abdullahi, Director Examinations, Admissions and Records (DEAR), said, under the new dispensation, the semester has 14 weeks duration with lectures to hold for 10 weeks commencing from 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 and ending on 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.

GSU examinations are to hold for three days between June 16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> while the Second Semester examinations will hold for 3 weeks between June 21<sup>st</sup> and July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
