# SCE Graduates First Set ... As 12 Students Bag First Class Honours

he Senate of Bayero University at its 386<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on Wednesday 5th May, 2021 considered and approved graduation of the first set of students from the School of Continuing Education (SCE).

A total of 716 students across various programmes graduated with different classes of degree among which 12 students graduated with First Class Honours including 3 BUK non-teaching staff, while 250 students graduated with Upper Second Class honours.

The graduates cut across four (4) departments with the Department of Social Sciences and Administration having the highest number of 476, followed by Department of Education with 180, while Departments of Arts and Humanities and Sciences have 48 and 12 respectively.

Salihu Lawal Malumfashi described the graduation as excellent.
