The Executive Secretary of the National Universities Commission (NUC) and former Vice Chancellor of Bayero University, Kano, Prof. Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, received the Hallmarks of Labour Award for Outstanding Contributions in the Field of Education.

Prof. Rasheed received the award titled: **HLF-UmaruShehu Life-Time Achievement Award to a Consistent Advocate of Positive Change within the University System** for his contributions in leading the Nigerian tertiary education system with dignity,

innovation and positive change.

The former VC was presented with the award during the Hallmarks of Labour 25th Anniversary and 2020/2021 role model awards held at the Oriental Hotel, Victoria Island, Lagos on Saturday, December 11, 2021.

Prof. Rasheed followed the foot-steps of former BUK Council Chairman, Prof. Ibrahim Gambari, who received HLF-EmekaAnyaku Lifetime Achievement Award for Nigeria's most outstanding international icon in May 29, 2016 and Prof. Attahiru Muhammadu Jega, who received a similar HLF-UmaruShehu Life-Time Achievement Award as the most consistent advocate for positive change within the university system in October 15, 2011.

The NUC Boss was accompanied by former Vice Chancellors, Prof. Shehu Galadanci, Prof. Attahiru Jega and the former Registrar, Fatima-Binta Mohammed among others. Nine other accomplished Nigerians were also honoured with the Hallmarks of Labour Leadership awards in different categories.

CDA Hosts North West's Validation Exercise for Draft of National Agricultural Technology and Innovation Policy

The Centre for Dryland Agriculture (CDA) on Saturday, 11th December, 2021 hosted the North West Regional Validation Exercise of the Draft National Agricultural Technology and Innovation Policy 2022-2025.

The exercise which was organized by the Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development with the support of CDA brought together stakeholders from the Northwest for sharing experience and making input into the draft national agricultural technology and innovation policy.

According to the Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development, Dr Mohammed Mahmud, who was represented by Alhaji Zubairu Abdullahi, the Director Planning and Policy Coordination, said the policy would enable the alignment of state, national and regional priorities to ensure ownership and collective implementation of the policy document in the country.

The Minister averred that the choice of Kano to host the exercise was in recognition of the state government's commitment to agricultural development as a way of diversifying the national economy towards ensuring food and nutrition security, employment generation and wealth creation.

The Minister commended the CDA for supporting the exercise in Kano, saying that the Centre is a major partner of the Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development towards addressing the challenges of food insecurity in the country.

The Director, Centre for Dryland Agriculture (CDA), Professor Jibrin Mohammed Jibrin, in his goodwill message, decried that despite its huge population Nigeria still imports food, noting also that agriculture that was supposed to be the mainstay of economy contributes negligibly to the Gross Domestic Product as oil provides 90% of the country's income. He said to make agriculture effective there must be sound and efficient policy to change the narrative.

The Director expressed happiness over the collaboration between the CDA and the Ministry, saying that the Centre

is ready to support the policy with the aim of boosting agriculture in Nigeria and West and Central Africa as a whole, which is part of its mandate.

Earlier in his welcome address, the Honourable Commissioner of Agriculture and Rural Development, Kano State, Dr. Nasir Yusuf Gawana (Dep. Governor), who was represented by Alhaji Hassan Balarabe Karaye, said the policy would be vital to agricultural development in Nigeria. He said Kano State Government is ever-ready to key into the policy and implement its recommendations made by the stakeholders.

The Country Director of SASAKAWA Africa, Professor Sani Miko, expressed dismay over lack of policy document in most states in Nigeria. He called on them to align their policies with that of the federal government in order to scale up the agricultural production in the country.

Goodwill messages were presented by Commissioners of Agriculture from Zamfara, Jigawa, Alhaji Jibo Magayaki and Alhaji Muhammad Alhassan respectively.

The validation exercise had been conducted in other geopolitical zones except the North Central. It is expected that the grand finale of key stakeholders' meeting will take place in Abuja where deliberations would be made before a final policy document is produced.

Speaking at the event, the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sagir Adamu Abbas, who was represented by the Director, Mambayya House, Prof. Ismaila M. Zango, highlighted on the negative repercussions of corruption which he said has

eaten deeply into all aspects of human endeavour. He said, Mambayya House worked in collaboration with many NGOs to fight corruption from the grassroots.

In his paper presentation titled: *Assessing the Anti-Corruption Efforts in Nigeria since 1999: Challenges and Prospects*, the Guest Speaker and the Executive Director, Centre for Information Technology and Development (CITAD), Mal. Yunusa Z. Ya'u discussed extensively on the historical antecedence of corruption in Nigeria.

Mal. Y. Z. Ya'u said much has not been done by the governments to fight corruption in Nigeria. He added that government alone cannot fight corruption but rather, there should be a collective effort by the entire citizens.

The Directorate of Research Innovation and Partnership (DRIP) has organized a workshop to build the capacity of BUK researchers drawn from different faculties and departments to enable them to access the 2021 TETfund

National Research Grant (NRF) The training took place on Thursday 9th December, 2021, at the Senate Building Training Room.

The Director, DRIP, Prof. I. A. Rufai, who was also the resource person, in his opening remarks, said the training which employed a tool called logical framework approach will effectively design project and ensure successful implementation of the project.

According to him, if there is no problem there will not be a project and that the project must solve an identified problem in a concrete way.

He said for a researcher to submit concept note he or she will be required to create a research team with at least 5 members and present the problem the project will focus on, describe project objectives; Describe all groups that will benefit from the project; discuss the expected accomplishment throughout the project, describe the type of activities that are planned within the project and also state the amount of funding required for the project.

Prof. A.R. Rufai, who disclosed that, TETfund can only finance projects that meet defined eligibility criteria and requirement that will contribute to the objective and goals

of NRF, said, a researcher must set the right proposal writing team by having a strong and visionary leader, 1 – 2 Key members, 1 – 2 young (mentally) energetic members from relevant disciplines, and good proposal writer.

He said the phases in developing fundable projects are analysis phase which includes stakeholder analysis, problem analysis, objective and strategy analysis: planning phase, which are developing logical framework matrix, activity and resource scheduling; and drafting phase which

are writing individual element. Validation and assembly of first draft, review and editing and final draft proof reading.

Problem analysis according to him are Confirmation of the Focal Problem; Identification of any additional problems linked directly to the Focal Problem in the concrete area; Determining problems important for the beneficiaries existing at the moment of project planning; and Sorting the problems to create a structure of cause effect relations, called a 'Problem Tree'.
