## 2025 WUR: BUK Excels Globally, Ranked among top 10 Nigerian Universities

As the Times Higher Education (*THE*) a renowned United Kingdom based education assessor releases the 2025 world university ranking,, Bayero University, Kano (BUK) has emerged as Nigeria's top university in terms of international outlook.

The 2025 World University Rankings (WUR) released on Wednesday, October 9, 2024 by the Times Higher Education (THE) provide a comprehensive league table of the world's best universities, assessing their global performance.

Notably, BUK scored an impressive 48.8% in international outlook, surpassing all 274 universities in Nigeria and emerged as 1215th in the global ranking.

The Times Higher Education World University Rankings are widely recognized as a benchmark of excellence in higher education, evaluating institutions based on key performance indicators such as teaching, research, knowledge transfer, and international outlook.

This achievement underscores BUK's commitment to fostering global connections, collaboration, and academic excellence.

In the overall national ranking, Bayero University came behind Covenant University who emerged as the first; Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria came second and Landmark University clinched the third position. Others are University of Ibadan, who came fourth, University of Lagos as fifth and BUK came 6<sup>th</sup>.

The current ranking methodology, developed in 2023, evaluates five key areas of Teaching, Research Environment, Research Quality, International Outlook and Industry. Relevant data are collected from 11 subject areas which included Arts and Humanities, Business and Economics, Clinical and Health, Computer Science, Education, Engineering, Law,

Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Psychology, and Social Sciences.

The methodology of the rankings is dynamic and regularly updated. In the 2025 exercise, 18 carefully calibrated performance indicators were collected to provide the most comprehensive and balanced comparisons, trusted by key stakeholders. A new metric (study abroad) was also introduced which would be reflected in future assessment.

The performance indicators are grouped into five areas which are; Teaching (the learning environment); Research environment (volume, income and reputation); Research quality (citation impact, research strength, research excellence and research influence); International outlook (staff, students and research); and Industry (income and patents).

During the 2025 exercise, a total of 2,857 institutions from 115 countries participated but only 2,092 met the inclusion criteria. Data was collected from the institutions in two ways:

- a) Institutional data submitted by the institutions on the THE Portal,
- b) Bibliometric data collected from Elsevier.

The performance of African universities in the 2025 WURs is presented in Table 1, where the University of Cape Town, South Africa emerged as the leading institution in the continent whilst Covenant University of Nigeria maintains its lead among the institutions that participated in the current rankings.

Starting from 2019, Bayero University had been benchmarking with six institutions in Africa; University of Ghana, University of Nairobi, University of Cape Town, University of Ibadan, University of Lagos and Covenant University.




Figure 1: Times Higher Education 2025 World University Rankings Methodology

The performance in the rankings shows while catching up with the University of Nairobi in Kenya, Bayero University is closely following its mentors and steadily making progress along the ladder. The performance of Bayero University among Nigerian universities over the past three years has been commendable. Bayero University has out-performed some of the first generation universities in international outlook.

Despite the fact that the ranking among Nigerian universities dropped by one position in comparison with 2024, the overall score and the exact position in the league table has improved as presented in Table 2. Specifically, there was a slight improvement in teaching and industry income as well as a significant improvement in research quality in the period under review.

Although the results of the ranking placed Bayero University as the 6th among the 274 institutions in Nigeria. However, breakdown of the results (Table 3) revealed that Bayero University outpaced all the 274 universities with a score of 48.8.
